

**NORTH SHORE CORVETTE CLUB
CROSSED FLAGS AWARD
PARTICIPATION POINTS**

Points are given to NSCC members as a way of recognizing or "rewarding" them for participating in and supporting club activities. Points are given as freely as possible as an incentive to increase participation in, and support of, club events.

General Guidelines:

The event must be open to all NSCC members.

The event must be on the calendar in advance and/or freely advertised to all members through the newsletter and/or flyers.

The event must be approved or sanctioned by the board as a NSCC event for points.

An event with less than 5 NSCC members does not qualify for chairperson points.

To receive points, a member must sign in or the chairperson must prepare a written attendance report. Sign in sheets and chairperson reports should include whether a member drove their Corvette.

Chairperson does not receive participation points except the NSCC car show.

Chairperson does not receive worker points with the exception of the car show.

Points at an event can be earned at up to four levels:

Chairperson

Worker

Participant

Supporter

GENERAL MEMBERSHIP POINTS: (except NSCC car show)	<u>POINTS</u>
Board Member: 12 pts. for the year plus 1 pt. for each board meeting attended	24 possible
Board approved committee chair (non board member)	12
Club member attending a board meeting as a guest	1
Attending a Membership meeting	2
Participating in an event	2
Working an event	2
Driving a Corvette to the event (except as an event supporter)	1
Supporting a sanctioned club event without participating in the entire event i.e. attending bowling, the car show, or a competitive event. A member will earn a maximum of 1 point for any event as a supporter even if they drive their Corvette.	1

CHAIRPERSON:

A chairperson is the person or persons primarily responsible for scheduling, planning, advertising, and running an event. Other people who assist receive worker points.

More than one person can receive chairperson points if they share the responsibility for planning, advertising, and running the event.

Competitive event:

- Gymkana, Rally or Drag Race planned for and run by NSCC 8
- Combined event with another club or organization's event i.e. gymkana, rally, or drag race where NSCC gives a separate trophy. 6

Road trips:

- Day trip or caravan [Fall leaf cruise; Indy 500 community day] 6
- Overnight to an event organized by another organization [Mid America Fun Fest; Corvette Museum; Fall Color Run] 8
- Road trip of 2-3 nights planned and led by the chairperson 10
- Road trip of 4 or more nights planned and led by the chairperson 12

NSCC Car show:

- Chairperson of the entire event 12
- Committee chairperson (responsible for planning, set-up and leading workers) 12
- Working on a committee in advance and at the event 5
- Worker the day of the event (per shift/job) 2
- Showing a car at the event 5
- Additional for showing more than 1 car (1 point per additional car) 1 per car

REFERRING A NEW MEMBER:
