#### **DRIVING TIPS FOR HAZARDOUS WEATHER**

#### **FOG**

- \* Use your wipers and defroster
- \* Don't use your high-beam headlights
- \* Keep enough distance between you and the car in front of you
- \* Slow down

#### **RAIN**

- \* Use your wipers and low-beam headlights
- \* Slow down
- \* If you begin hydroplaning take your foot off the accelerator

#### HIGH WINDS/ DUST STORM

- \* Use your wipers and low-beam headlights
- \* Slow down
- If you begin hydroplaning take your foot off the accelerator

#### SNOW/ICE

- \* Keep all windows clear for better visibility
- \* Use low-beam headlights
- \* Slow down
- \* If you begin to skid, let up on accelerator and turn wheels towards skid direction


