

# Charity Committee



Hello everyone from the NSCC Charity Committee. This is our 3<sup>rd</sup> official year in existence and we'd like to thank you for another great year. Because of member generosity and a charity budget of \$800.00, we were able to accomplish the following in **2018/2019**:

**\$100** to ***Feed My Starving Children*** (charity budget). We also had 26 people participate in the hands-on packing event where we packed 113 boxes which equated to 24,408 meals.

**\$250** to purchase toiletries for ***PADS*** (charity budget). We were able to donate more than 1,400 items to PADS because members donated cash in addition to many toiletries.

**\$300** for ***school supplies*** (charity budget)

**\$150** for ***mittens/hats/scarves*** (charity budget). We also had numerous donations of hats/scarves/mittens and gloves from club members.

### **PREVENT FALLS AROUND THE HOME**



## USE CAR'S EXHAUST TO CLEAN CUSHIONS



Using the exhaust gas of the automobile to clean the upholstery is the accomplishment of a recently invented device. An aluminum attachment is fastened to the exhaust pipe and the engine is allowed to idle. As the exhaust gas passes through this device suction is created at the inlet hole. Collected by a nozzle, the dust and dirt are drawn through the hose and expelled into the air at the rear of the car. It is made in three models, for cars of different size.

With the car's engine idling, gas from the exhaust creates a vacuum that cleans the cushions




