

Safety Tip of the Month

Caravan Reminders

Н

Being in a caravan does not increase your safety on the road and can increase your risk. Here are some things to do and things not to do.

- •Keep a safe interval, depending on conditions, without lagging behind (recommend the 3 second rule).
- ·Let a metal car pass and get in line when they want to. Other drivers on the road can be frustrated or challenged by a long caravan. No need for road rage.
- •If you feel that conditions are unsafe, breakout of the caravan. Wait until you feel it is safe for you to follow, you can always get back in the caravan farther down the road.
- ·If you are near the back of the caravan and the leader indicates he is going to change lanes, move over as soon as it is safe, this makes it easier for the other cars in front of you to change lanes.
- •Keep your FRS radio and cell phone (hands free) handy for directions and safety warnings.
- •If you need or want to leave the caravan for any reason, notify the leader. The message may have to be passed on by drivers closer to the leader. We will not worry about you leaving the caravan as long as we are informed that you are safe. We never leave a driver alone.
- •When we are on a four-lane road and we approach a stoplight, it is helpful for the caravan to take up both lanes. A single line can be made later when it is safe.
- •And always drive at your own comfort level. If you wish to fall back, let the caboose driver be aware so not to spread out the group.

Always drive safely!

Corvette Racing Scores Class Win at 12 Hours of Sebring

After finishing mid-pack at Daytona, Corvette Racing claims the top spot in the GTD Pro class.









Corvette Racing Wins the 12 Hours of Sebring Race

SEBRING, FL (March 19, 2022) - Corvette Racing made it a dozen victories in the Mobil 1 Twelve Hours of Sebring on Saturday the first victory in America's oldest sports car race for the mid-engine Chevrolet Corvette C8.R.

Antonio Garcia, Jordan Taylor, and Nicky Catsburg teamed for the landmark win with the No. 3 Mobil1/SiriusXM Corvette in the second round of the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship. The trio combined to lead 247 laps or 913 miles for Corvette Racing first Sebring 12 Hours win since 2017 and 12th since 2002.

It also marks the first win for the GTD PRO-spec Corvette C8.R in its second race as part of the new class. The result goes along with a runner-up GTE Pro finish for Tommy Milner and Nick Tandy in Friday's 1,000 Miles of Sebring for the FIA World Endurance Championship.

"This win is even more special thanks to the support of so many Corvette owners and fans at the track and around the world. This has been a great weekend with a runner-up class finish in the World Endurance Championship on Friday and now this win in IMSA." said Jim Campbell, Chevrolet U.S. vice president, Performance and Motorsports.
