Safety Tip of the Month

Pires may be the most misunderstood component on your car.

Compared to those made a decade ago, they still require some degree of care to maximize their lifespans. Modern tire compounds have evolved at an incredibility fast pass, yet we need to know more.

As for Summer-only performance tires, they offer a great grip, but the window for their use is a smaller window. Some manufacturers warn that these tires may be subject to sidewall cracking in low temperatures and using them at this time will void any manufactures warranty.

According to Goodyear, sidewall and tread weathering, known as dry rot, is a result of the breakdown of compounds. UV exposure, environments with extreme hot and dry climates can accelerate the breakdown.

Cover any tires that may be directly exposed to sunlight, even through a window, when parked for an extended time. Repeated movement of the tire compounds actually helps deter cracks from forming. For a stored vehicle, repositioning the tire every month is helpful.

Tire appearance: some tire dressings contain petroleum distillates, and in the long run can prematurely age a tire. They suggest cleaning them with water and mild dish soap and rinsing with clean water.

For dressings, opt for a water-based product that doesn't contain petroleum distillates. Keep in mind that tires can also age from the inside out and there is no way to know if an aged tire is safe. Rule of thumb is the 10-year rule.

This rule is much safer and cheaper for tires than a potential bad outcome of an accident.


