Watch for a Car Show helpers' sign-up sheet. We will need all the help we can get.



Many Great Announcements in September

GM is making a lot of announcements in September regarding the Corvette Plant in Bowling Green, production schedule for the ZO6, the list of restrictions for the plant in building Corvettes. Due to the complexity and the many parts required for different models the plant has a number of restrictions: Here is a partial list-

Convertibles—no more than two in a row

ZO6— No more than two per hour

Export—6PF No back to back builds

RHD— build in batches only-weekly constraints

Japan— No back to back

California Emissions—No back to back

70th Anniversary— No back to back

Dual tops—No back to back

Front Lift—No more than three in a row

25% Color-Max of same paint color per day

The first big announcement is the start of plant tours at the Bowling Green Assembly Plant beginning in **November 2022.**

The engine build for the new LT6 Flat Plane Crank DOHC engine will be available for those owners who elect to build it in **April 2023.** So we hope to keep you informed as information is available.

School Buses and Emergency Vehicles

It's that time of the year again and the school buses are out in force. School bus laws to alert motorists of pending actions:

Yellow flashing lights indicates the bus is preparing to stop and motorists should slow down to prepare to stop

Red flashing lights and extended stop arms indicate the bus has stopped. Motorists must stop their cars and wait until red lights stop flashing, the extended arms are withdrawn, and the bus begins to move before you can proceed. The only time a vehicle is **not** required to stop is when both vehicles are on a four lane-lane roadway and the bus is stopped in the opposite direction from which the driver is traveling. One must be very cautious because some drivers do not know this rule and will stop in your lane.

A reminder of <u>Scott's Law</u>, known as "<u>Move Over Law</u>". It is mandatory that when approaching any police or other emergency vehicle, including snowplows and tow trucks, the law means, you must: change lanes if possible, always reduce speed, but greatly reduce speed if you cannot change lanes.


