Safety Tip of the Month

Change your Clocks and Batteries in your Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detectors

You should change the batteries in your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors every six months. To help you remember when you change your clocks, change the batteries.

It's important to have a smoke detector on every floor. In every bedroom and in the garage. Every floor should have a carbon monoxide detector and the garage.

Smoke detectors should be replaced every 10 years and carbon monoxide detectors every five to seven years. There should be a date on the back on the back, it's a good idea to mark the front with a replacement date. The detector's alarm function should be manually checked once a month.

There are two types of smoke detectors- Ionization and Photoelectric. Ionization is quicker to warn about flaming fires, were Photoelectric are best at warning about smothering fires, which is often the case in a garage.

Carbon monoxide detectors detect a poisonous gas that can be a home's furnace, clothes dryers, fireplaces, and garage heaters. In case of a detection alarm it is critical to get everyone to fresh air as soon as possible. This can be placed on a wall 5 feet above the floor or on the ceiling.

Changing the clocks next Spring may be the last clock change, a new method for reminding you to check the batteries will be required.

- *Service*. It is our honor and privilege to place others before ourselves with our charity activities.




