

Safety Tip of the Month

Safety at Home for the Holidays



OUTDOOR Decorations - Follow these safety tips when stringing lights. If you use a ladder, position it on a level surface; if necessary, ask a second person to hold the ladder secure. Wear shoes or boots that won't slip. Make sure all of the outdoor lights and extension cords are waterproof and rated for outdoor use and keep connections above ground, snow, and water. Do not use nails or staples to hang lights, use insulated light clips such as plastic.

Maintain a Safe Christmas Tree – If you select a live tree, make sure it is fresh; cut off about 2 inches of the trunk to expose fresh wood for better absorption. With the possibility of a shortage of trees available this year, buying early will mean a longer time indoors so remember to maintain water in the stand. Maintain at least 3 feet from any heat source. Turn off all lights and decorations when going to bed or leaving the house.

Pet Safety — Keep your pets away from mistletoe which is toxic and other poisonous plants like holly berries, Jerusalem cherry, and amaryllis.

Food Poisoning – Refrigerate hot or cold leftovers within two hours of being served. Keep raw meat away from fresh produce. Most leftovers are safe for three or four days when properly refrigerated.

Electric Portable Space Heater - Keep the heater at least 3 feet away from anything that can burn, that includes people. Make sure your heater has an auto shut-off to turn the heater off if it tips over. Check manual if extension cords are allowed otherwise plug directly into wall outlet. They should be turned off and unplugged when leaving the room or going to bed.

Cooking Fires remain the #1 cause of residential fires. Keep the proper fire extinguisher, multipurpose type A-B-C in the kitchen. Keep flammable items away from the stove top.

Most importantly have a safe and happy holiday.


