Early Spring is Here

Spring weather is unpredictable, lightning, flooding, and even tornadoes. Be Prepared: have a batter operated flashlight. Portable charger for your cell phone – Apps like NBC Chicago can track storms warnings and location.

Know where to go for you and your family to be safe. Also know how to turn off the water, gas, and electricity. Time to check all fire extinguisher indicator needles and dates in order to operate correctly.

Early Spring Driving: Prepare for potholes, if you can not avoid, slow down and right before crossing over the pothole release the brakes.

Watch out for ice patches and once again black ice just like in the Fall. Driving in the rain precents its own problems. Keep a safe distance, the driver in front of you may only be a "Fair Weather Driver" making panic stops often.

The rainy season will require good windshield wipers. Give them a test in your driveway to make sure there is no wet spots or leaving a smeared windshield.

Another problem is the early morning and evening sun glare, the cause of many accidents. Always have a pair of polarized sunglasses in your car and anther good reason to have a clean windshield.




