# **April Showers Bring-WET ROARDS**

Н

uring heavy rain conditions and flooding---Don't drive if you don't have to, wait till the worst has passed. But if you have to drive, **Slow down**, driving too fast will most likely cause hydroplaning and losing control of your vehicle. Turn on your rear defroster to avoid windshield fogging. That rule of thumb – wipers on headlights on—make yourself visible to other drivers. Avoid hard braking and sudden movements. Another saying—turn around, don't drown. It takes only 12 inches of rushing water to carry away most cars and driving at night especially makes seeing flooded roadways difficult. Driving in another vehicle's tracks makes it easy for your tires to handle the water. Avoid large trucks and buses—there spray can reduce your visibility. Be ready for gusty winds which can push your car and other vehicles around. Keep a firm grip on your steering wheel. If possible, drive in the middle lane where there is generally less ponding of water. Check the tread on your tires and the air pressure. Being late is always better than never getting there.







#### From our Constitution ARTICLE 2 ELECTIONS

- A. At a Board of Directors meeting to be held not later than the March membership meeting, the Board of Directors shall select a Nominating Committee consisting of (3) members. The Nominating Committee shall obtain from the membership the names of the members nominated for each position on the Board of Directors and submit the names at the April membership meeting.
- B. The elections shall take place at the May membership meeting and shall be by ballot. The nominees receiving the most votes for the positions will be declared the winner.
- C. Any Member who holds or desires to run for an elected position who sells or disposes of their Corvette, but wants to retain their eligibility for the elected position in the club; has a 60-day grace period to replace their Corvette, or (2) the member may request a hearing from the Board of Directors to retain their eligibility for the elected position.
- D. In the event of a vacancy in any office, the Board of Directors shall appoint a member to fill the vacancy. Such appointment shall be confirmed by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Board of Directors. This shall be accomplished as quickly as possible to reduce the time a position is vacant.
- E. Members wising to vote by absentee ballot may request a ballot with instructions from the club secretary. If the instructions on the ballot are not followed, the ballot will be considered null and void.
- F. There shall be three (3) ballot counters at all times, one of which shall be a member of the Board of Directors.
- G. Ballots will be made available for recount if so requested by any persons running for that specific office.
- H. For any member to be considered eligible for nomination to any elected club position, he or she must either be presented at the nominating meeting or make his or her intentions known in writing and in the hands of the club Secretary five (5) days prior to the nominating meeting. No NSCC member shall hold, be nominated or elected to an office in NSCC while holding any official position in an other car-oriented club. Any potential conflicts will be addressed by the existing board. The Board's decision will be final.
- I. Any member wishing to run for the position of President must have served a minimum of two (2) terms on the Board of Directors in an position. The two terms must have been served during the member's present and contiguous years of membership. The two terms do not have to be served contiguously during that period of time.

- *Service*. It is our honor and privilege to place others before ourselves with our charity activities.






