# The Sun is our Friend... Maybe

#### **SUNBURN**

#### SKIN CANCER

This is the most common type of cancer in the US. It's also one of the most preventable. With summer around the corner, it's a great time to learn about sunburn and protect yourself.

We all enjoy the outdoors and having a nice tan, but the sun can be your enemy. Sun damage isn't always visible. Ultraviolet light can prematurely age your skin and over time lead to deadly melanoma.

Besides your skin turning red, you may feel like you have the flu, feverish, chills, nausea, headache, and weakness.

#### SUNBURN RELIEF

There are treatments is to relieve the redden, inflamed skin while easing the pain. A few home remedies: Apply cold compresses to your skin or take a cool bath to soothe the burn. Cream or gels can take out the sting by gently rubbing on a substance containing ingredients such as Menthol, Camphor, or Aloe. Also, NSAIDs like ibuprofen or naproxen can relieve sunburn swelling and pain. At this time stay hydrated and avoid the sun and call your doctor if necessary.

#### **PREVENTION**

This is the best policy. Keep track time of your exposure. Wear the right clothes, such as a broad-brimmed hat, a long sleeve shirt and UV-blocking sunglasses. Use sunscreen- a sun protection factor (SPF) of at least 30. Apply about 30 minutes before going outside. Reapply every two hours or more often if you are swimming or sweating heavily.

While driving your Corvette with the top down or removed, be protected- wear a hat and put on the sunscreen.






